ONE DIRECTOR OF THE MAINE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE DISTRICT #41 FOR A TERM OF ONE (1) YEAR.

ARTICLE 17

TO SEE IF THE TOWN WILL AUTHORIZE THE SELECTMEN, ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN, TO SELL AND DISPOSE OF ANY REAL ESTATE ACQUIRED BY THE TOWN FOR NON-PAYMENT OF TAXES THEREON, ON SUCH TERMS AS THE BOARD DEEMS ADVISABLE AND IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE MUNICIPALITY, AND TO EXECUTE QUITCLAIM DEEDS FOR SUCH PROPERTY.

RECOMMENDED BY THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN

ARTICLE 18

TO SEE IF THE TOWN WILL VOTE THAT TAXES SHALL BE DUE AND PAYABLE IN TWO EQUAL INSTALLMENTS ON AUGUST 15, 2010 AND DECEMBER 15, 2010 WITH INTEREST OF 7.0% PER ANNUM TO BE CHARGED ON ALL TAXES REMAINING UNPAID AFTER THE RESPECTIVE DUE DATES, TO SET THE INTEREST RATE ON ABATED TAXES AT 3.0% FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2010 AND TO SEE IF THE TOWN WILL VOTE TO AUTHORIZE THE TAX COLLECTOR AND/OR TREASURER TO ACCEPT PREPAYMENTS OF TAXES NOT YET DUE OR ASSESSED AND TO PAY NO INTEREST THEREON.
