Kelly Disley formally requested copies of all information and reports pertaining to her complaint regarding the actions of three (3) Milo Police Officers. Mrs. Disley was informed that the documents she was requesting were classified confidential under State of Maine Statute. Mrs. Disley expressed her deep dissatisfaction.

**AGENDA:**

Eastern Piscataquis Industrial Park:

The Town Manager updated the Board regarding funding for the Industrial Park in the aftermath of the defeat of the County Bond Initiative. The Town will pursue the possibility of including funds for the projects in the Governor's June Statewide Economic Development Bond Package and continue to work on other grant opportunities.

The May Regional Hospital medical facility project cost estimate has increased from the original \$450,000 to \$1.3 million. The Town is participating in a \$300,000 multi-jurisdictional CDBG Public Facilities Grant Application to assist with the Project. A Public Hearing on the application has been set for November 30<sup>th</sup>, with Milo hosting.

The site survey and mapping for the Project is currently being completed by CES and should be available shortly.

Fiscal Review:

The Town Manager updated the Board regarding Revenue Sharing proceeds which are running above projections. All other accounts remain in good standing.

**OTHER OLD/NEW BUSINESS:**

- 1.) The Board set Tuesday, November 30<sup>th</sup>, for its next meeting to also include a Public Hearing.
- 2.) Joseph Beres made the Motion to sign Abatements as presented. Second – Jerry Cole. Passed – unanimously.
- 3.) Jerry Cole made the Motion to sign Warrants #36, #37 and #38 as presented. Second – Joseph Beres. Passed – unanimously.

**OTHER:**

The Town Manager updated the Board regarding a proposed Dog Sled Race that AMC would like to sponsor from Greenville to Brownville. One major obstacle in the growth of dog sledding or any other recreational/tourism attraction is the lack of overnight accommodations in Eastern Piscataquis. The Town Manager sought and received Board approval to pursue a Planning Grant to evaluate the situation.
